- Commitment from company; assign focal person
- Chemonics will conduct RECP assessments of at least 30-40 companies which will include:
 - A quick visit of the companies
 - A half-day visit, workshop and discussion with technical and decision-maker personnel at each targeted company to identify possible RECP interventions.
 - The expected economic, social and environmental benefits, as well as the expected reduction in energy, material, water and chemicals consumption of the opportunities will be estimated.





Implementation of RECP interventions and monitoring

- Provide hands-on training activities for the participating company and park management teams for the implementation of the opportunities identified.
- Establish an implementation plan for each RECP and industrial symbiosis intervention identified.
- Monitor the impact of the implemented RECP and industrial symbiosis options in terms of resource consumption and related financial savings.
- A minimum of two follow-up visits three months after finishing the RECP/IS assessment and at the end of the assignment will be conducted.
