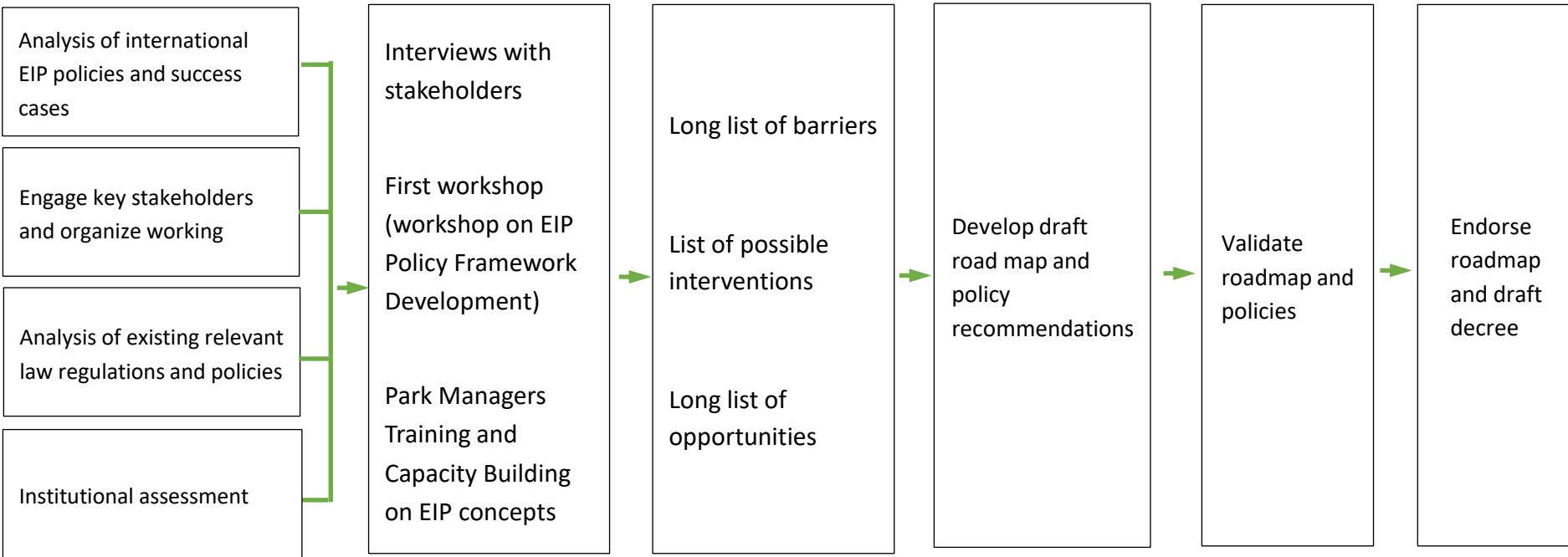

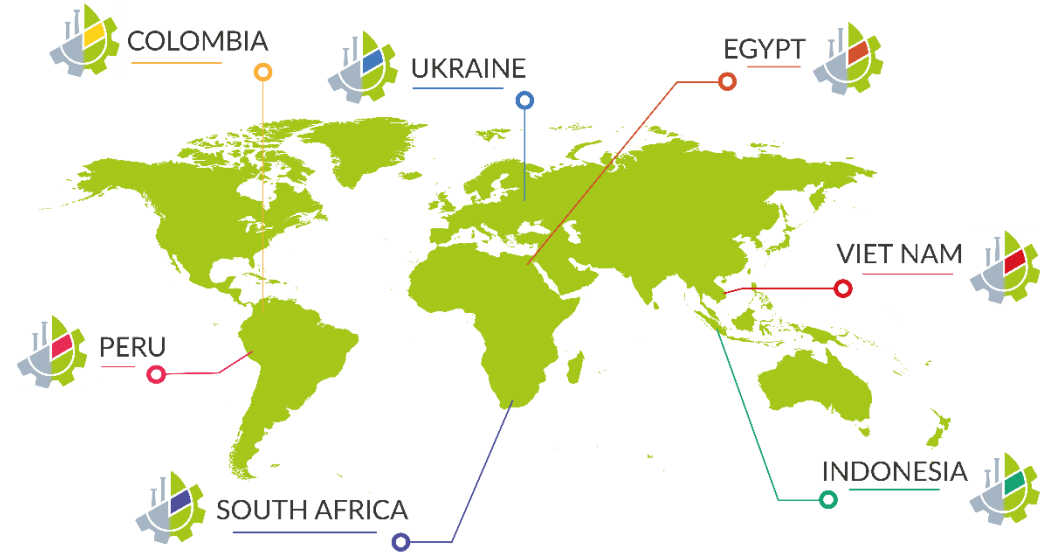

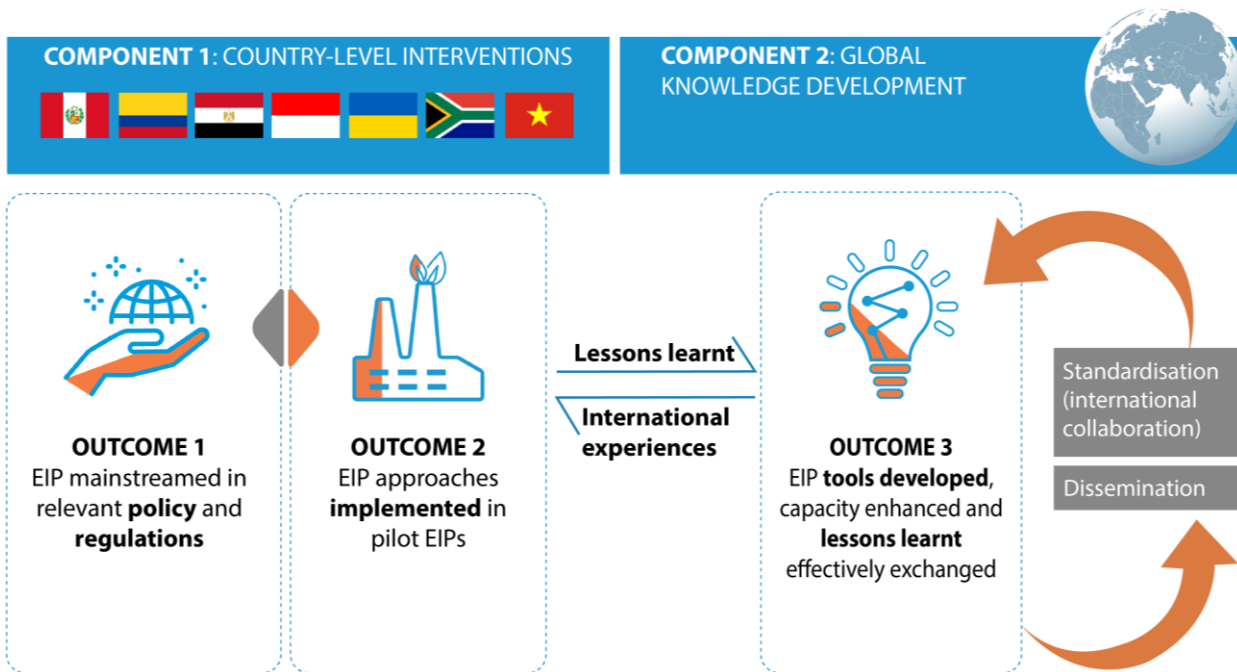

- Project budget: 1.672.536 Euros
- Project period: 36 months

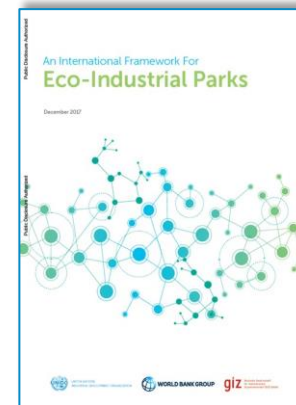
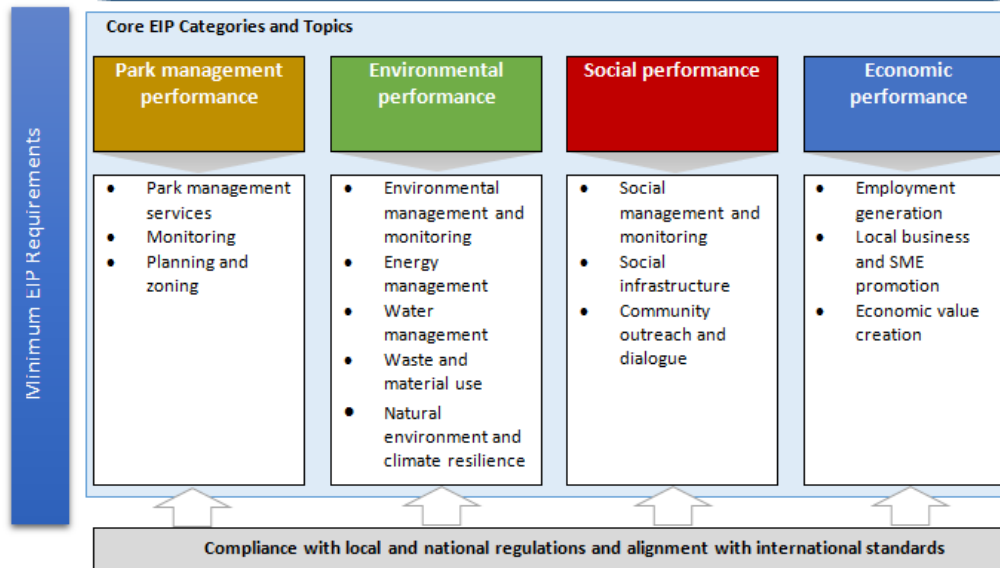
Component 2:
